



Addressing the media here on Tuesday, Bandi and the Telangana Chief Minister and the then Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu had signed an agreement in the first Apex Committee meeting, where KCR had agreed for 512 cubic ft Krishna water to Andhra Pradesh and 299 tmcft to Telangana.

He asked K Chandrasekhar Rao to rub his nose to the ground as he had agreed to 509 tmcft Krishna water in Telangana. "In case my charges are wrong, then I will not be able to pump into Srikrishna and will be held responsible," he said.

The BJP State chief accused the chief ministers of AP and Telangana of encroaching areas to lunuchayi people in the name of river water sharing for political gains. Hollingollingollis in support of his stance, the BJP State chief said that both the States have met thrice during 2014-15, and the Telangana had agreed for 299 tmcft as its share and signed on the same before the Centre.

Both the chief ministers have been amassing thousands of crores of public money in the name of construction of projects. The Karimnagar MP questioned whether it was not a fact that CM KCR had given his word to expand cooperation for the expansion of

Pitalkote irrigation and the construction of Sangamneram projects in AP?

He said K Chandrasekhar Rao compromised with TS Jagan Mohan Reddy agreeing to Krishna waters sharing in the ratio of 54:46, respectively.

Further, the Union Jal Shakti Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat has convened the Apex Committee meetings twice to do

justice for both the Telangana states. However, CM KCR made them postpone. Even when he attended the Apex Committee meeting on October 6, 2020, the Chief Minister remained silent on the illegal construction of projects by AP. Bandi pointed out.

The Governor, through a virtual mode from Raj Bhawan,


was speaking on importance of maternal health and child care as part of the "Safe Motherhood Week and Child Care celebrations" organized by IMA, Tamil Nadu.


