

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- A. First Party is a Higher Educational institution named: **Vaageswari College of Engineering**, engaged in academics in engineering fields.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. CLAUSE – 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the institution and its related wings. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of the First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. 2.6 Faculty Development Programs: Second Party will train the Faculties of the First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirements as per standards in concerned sector.



5 CLAUSE - 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither party shall have, nor present itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other party, to pledge the other Party's credit or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.





WHEREAS


- A). The first party is a Professional Educational Institution named: VAAGESWARI COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING – KARIMNAGAR,



2.5 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions and licenses of whatsoever nature required.

**LICENSING AND SERVICES AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
JRSPF TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD & VAAGESWARI COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING**

This Licensing & Services Agreement (this "Agreement") made effective as of 17-03-2022 (the "Effective Date") is between JRSPF Technologies Private Limited, with a principal place of business at B107, S.G. Palya, Bengaluru, Karnataka, 560095 ("Company") and Vaageswari College of Engineering located in Karimnagar, TS ("Institution"). Both Company and Institution may here in after be referred to as a "Party" and collectively, the "Parties."


WHEREAS The Company has developed a proprietary platform ("Platform") with a suite of tightly integrated products to improve respective educational outcomes for students, faculty, staff, management, and all relevant stakeholders.

WHEREAS the Institution has multiple programs spread across from Under_graduation to post-graduation within its campuses.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

General Terms of the Agreement

1. **Intellectual Property** As between the Parties, the Company retain all rights in the Platform, 42 Properties, Services, other 42 products, and content generated by the contractors/Staff or partners of the Company
2. **Taxes.** Each Party will be responsible for the payment of all central, state, and local sales, use, value-added or other taxes that are levied or imposed on it because of the transactions under this Agreement (other than for taxes based on the other Party's income). If a Party is required to pay any such taxes for which the other Party is responsible, then the taxes will be billed to and paid by such other Party.
3. **Single point of contact (SPOC) Person.** The Institution shall designate one or more persons as the point of contact for all coordination activities with the Company. This point of contact shall be a senior faculty member or a senior academic administrator. The Contact person from Vaageswari College of Engineering is Dr.Ch.Srinivas , Principal and from the JRSPF is_Rajasekhar Kogant'
4. **Office Space.** The Institution shall give an office space that can fit up to 6 employees of the Company with computer systems with 16 GB memory, electricity, and internet.
5. **Confidentiality obligations.** The recipient of any Confidential Information will not disclose that Confidential Information except to affiliates, employees, agents, and professional advisors who need to know it and who have agreed in writing (or in the case of professional advisors are otherwise bound) to keep it confidential. The recipient will ensure that those people and entities use such Confidential Information only to exercise rights and fulfill obligations under this Agreement while using reasonable care to protect it. The recipient may also disclose Confidential Information when required by law after giving reasonable notice to the discloser if permitted by law.

6. **Personal Data.** The Parties shall comply with the provisions and obligations imposed by the Data Protection Laws at all times when processing Personal Data in connection with this Agreement.
7. **Allowable Marketing.** Each Party may reach out to Learners regarding respective Party-sponsored activities. Such calls, emails, and text messages must be consistent with Each Party's high standards and not impose an unreasonable intrusion on a Learner's time or resources.
8. **Targeted Marketing.** Each Party agrees to reach out to Activated Learners for any up sales. "Activated Learners" means Learners who have meaningfully engaged in the Company's Course within the last two years.
9. **Indemnification.** To the extent permitted by law, each Party will indemnify, defend and hold harmless its affiliates and each of their officers, directors, employees, and its agents from and against any or all losses arising out of or resulting from any claims.
10. **Force Majeure.** Neither Party will be liable for inadequate performance to the extent caused by a condition (for example, natural disaster, an act of war or terrorism, riot, labor condition, governmental action, & others) beyond the Party's reasonable control.
11. **Term and Termination.** This Agreement will commence on the Effective Date and is valid for Five Years, and will continue in effect until terminated by either of parties.
12. **Compliance with Laws.** Each Party will comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations, as amended from time to time, applicable to such Party's performance of its obligations under this Agreement.
13. **Non-Exclusivity.** During the term of this Agreement, the Consultant shall be free to render services to other entities, and shall not have an exclusive relationship with the Company.
14. **Dispute Resolution.** All settlement of disputes or differences whatsoever, arising between the parties out of or in connection to the construction, meaning and operation or effect of this Agreement or in the discharge of any obligation arising under this Agreement (whether during the course of execution of the order or after completion and whether before or after termination, abandonment or breach of the Agreement) shall be resolved amicably between the Company and the institution.
 - a. In case of failure to resolve the disputes and differences amicably within 30 days of thereceipt of notice by the other party, then the same shall be resolved as follows:

"Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating to the construction, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this contract or the validity or the breach thereof shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties."
 - b. The venue of the arbitration shall be Bengaluru, and the number of arbitrators shall be three and the language of arbitration shall be English.
 - c. The award shall be final and binding on both the parties.
15. **Governing Law and Jurisdiction.** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Bengaluru in accordance with the laws and regulations of India without giving effect to conflicts of law principles.

DETAILED SCOPE OF SERVICES

Scope of Services (1): Licensing of Learning Management System (LMS) for the Institution

1. As per the terms of the Agreement, the Company will implement the Learning Management System (LMS) with respective modules shown below:

- a. **LMS Platform.** Digitizing the entire Learning process for students, faculty, and management as follows:
 - i. Lessons Planning
 - ii. HW (Home Work) and Exam Submissions with Grades
 - iii. Communications Platform
 - iv. Engagement Analytics
 - v. Embedded Coding Compilers
 - vi. Accessibility to Skill Development Programs
- b. **Proctoring Exams.** An AI-enabled proctoring system tailored to meet the demand from both external and internal environments.
- c. **Placement Platform.** A platform to manage the end-to-end placement activity.

Obligations of the Institution

The Institution is expected to "fair use" data storage amounts only required for academic purposes allocated by Company.

Licensing / Service Fee

- For the Scope of Services in section (1), the licensing & implementation fee for the items against (a), (b), and (c) points have been waived.

Scope of Services (2): TRAINING & PLACEMENT SERVICES

2. The Institution hereby authorizes the Company and its Partners for training and placement activities. The company agrees to:

- a. Identify students' interests and capabilities across related areas
- b. Train students to develop (i) communication skills, (ii) aptitude, (iii) excel, (iv) resume development, and (v) technical skills that move to very advanced levels year on year.
- c. Technical Programs involves Full Stack, Data Science,
- d. Total Hours for this program will be 40 hours per year for the entire duration of the regular program
- e. Assist with the placement activity to secure jobs in companies with greater than 5 Lakh Packages for B.Tech, M.Tech, MBA and MCA Programs while 4 Lakh for 3- year Degree programs
- f. Provide all examination papers for the proctored and in-class exams

Obligations of the Institution.

The Institution shall coordinate with the Company to ensure 85% attendance from all students for all sessions, have them complete all assignments, projects, viva, and mock interviews as required, and issue certificates in partnership with the Company for students who completed the program.




Service Fee

1. For the Scope of Services, the One-time ("Upfront") fees for the Post-Paid Model of Rs TBD per year per student respectively will be paid by the institution on a pro-rata basis annually.
 - a. One-month Salary of the annual CTC on acceptance of the job offer that can be paid either by the student or parent directly in 6 installments after the placement regardless of the source of placements received within the first six months of graduation or training, whichever is later
2. For the Scope of Services, the One-time ("Upfront") fees for the Pre-Paid Model of Rs. TBD per year per student for students of Degree programs, and TBD per student per year for students of B.Tech, M.Tech, MBA and MCA Programs or other programs who are participating on the placement services.
3. For the Scope of Services, the 50% of amount will be refunded if the students haven't been placed within 4 months of graduation.
4. At the beginning of the academic year, the Company will issue an invoice to the institution with details of the list of students enrolled through the institution. The institution will release the payment by wire transfer remittance or by such other means as shall be mutually agreed between the parties within 30 business days of receiving an invoice from the Company.




